The modular IM Program consists of 3 modules which offer knowledge through a set of engaging activities which better prepare the VET practitioners to plan and implement successful motilities and asses the outcomes and impact of the mobility on the learners' professional, academic and personal life.

The IM Learning Program is a blended learning solution with face to face sessions as well as online activities through the IM e-Learning platform.

The training materials consist of 3 modules

M1. Developing intercultural competence through cultural awareness and effective intercultural communication.

This first module aims to develop and enhance the intercultural competencies of VET practitioners engaged in intercultural mobility programmes and experiences. By reflecting on and developing their own intercultural competencies, organisations and practitioners will be able to work more effectively with learners and participants in intercultural VET contexts.

M2. Develop and manage VET intercultural mobility programmes

This module aims to support intercultural VET practitioners and organisations to understand the different types of intercultural VET programmes and experiences, how to plan for them effectively, meet the diverse needs of participants and create and sustain effective international VET partnerships.

M3. Utilise appropriate strategies and tools to recognise and validate participants' learning through intercultural VET mobility experience .

This module aims to support VET providers and practitioners to add value to intercultural VET experiences through familiarity with, and the use of, a range of appropriate tools and methodologies that can recognise, assess and validate the experiences, learning and achievements of young people taking part in intercultural VET mobilities.


